

OUT OF THE BOX POETRY QUICKWRITES

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Creative Ways to Use the Unit:

- Traditional Method: Choose a limited time frame in which to complete the activities.
- Extra Challenge Method: Include Challenges.
- Take it to the next level by using vocabulary words.
- Require students to use their dictation skills.
- Ask volunteers to read their poem.
- Randomly choose one of the volunteers to read their poem.
- Use three of the Dive Deep Word Strips. This can serve as a writing exercise.
- Try giving students more time than usual to really explore their ideas.
- Have an Out of the Box contest winner come up with their own words.
- As a homework assignment, ask your class "vessel".
- Decorate a bulletin board using the words from the poems your class has written.
- Use the blank cards to come up with a class novel.
- Have students work in cooperative groups to write a group poem about a specific book, theme, or topic.

Out of the Box Poetry Quickwrites

You will love the wonderful poetry your students will write by using this versatile poetry quickwriting method! It is a surefire way to get your students to move out of their comfort zone and think "out of the box." There are many ways to use these fun but challenging quickwritings!

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The only difference between the Seahorse and Starfish is the design.

Overview:

The concept is simple: assign your students a word that they have to use in a poem. Give them a few minutes to write and then share using the poetry box.

The words may seem random, but they are carefully chosen to inspire imagery and imagination. Many have multiple meanings. Since verbs often make verb beats, like Seahorse and Starfish Word Strips include many verbs. It is best that they be verbs when given an adjective; students often take the easy route and substitute adjectives for nouns. This just results in strange poems about fluffy bridges or timid alligators!

At the beginning, I probably rhymed poems. It's just a personal preference; I feel that adding rhyming poems results in forced rhyming, which ruins "I love my puppy" as much as anything else.

Begin by printing the strips; you can print on cardstock, or paper, or you can even print them on paper and laminate them. Then you will cut the Seahorse and Starfish Word Strips apart and tape them in a box. If I sometimes use a reveal, I use a decorative box, and students are very enthusiastic when they see me pull it out.

Treasure Chest Word Strips are the challenge strips requiring students to either include a specific literary device or write a certain form of poetry. I keep them in a separate box. I don't always use them, but when I do I sometimes present them as a "hidden challenge," for purpose of differentiation.

Dive Deep Word Strips are strips composed mostly of adjectives and adverbs. They can be used in conjunction with the other strips or they can be used alone for interesting descriptive poems.
